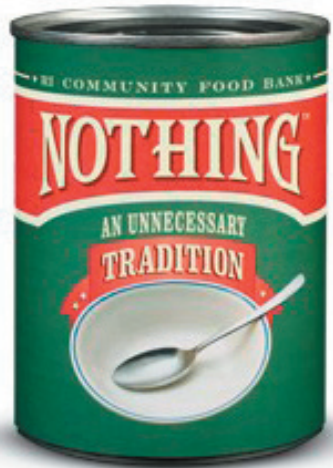


YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE FOR RHODE ISLAND'S HUNGRY

Helping the Rhode Island Community Food Bank alleviate hunger in our community is easy. Your school, faith community or civic group can help the Food Bank raise funds for the hungry by filling cans of Nothing with coins for donations. We'll even give you the cans!

Here's how it works:

1. Submit your request for cans in writing, via email or traditional mail. Requests submitted by mail should be sent to: Andrew Schiff, CEO, RI Community Food Bank, 200 Niantic Avenue, Providence, RI 02907. Email requests should be sent to aschiff@rifoodbank.org.
2. Only official requests, approved by your organization's administration, will be considered.
3. Once your request is approved, your organization agrees to:
 - Pick up the cans of Nothing at the Food Bank.
 - Provide the cans to your students or members free of charge.
 - Collect the cans filled from your students or members.
 - Count the change and send a check to the RI Community Food Bank representing the total amount collected.
